

1.5 Hours Nature's Own Sculpture Trail Godden Green/Knole

What3Words Navigation

Download the What3Word App



At the start, use Navigate and the What3Words compass towards the first tree.

When you have found the first tree navigate towards the 2nd, and so on. It will lead you easily round the route.

Stay on the paths until close to a tree, visit the tree and return to the path to continue.

Directions

Park on Park Lane, Godden Green, Sevenoaks TN15 0JJ.

Take path to R of pub & row of cottages [///rang.limit.erase](https://www.what3words.com/rang.limit.erase).

Walk ahead through stables, cross the track to the footpath ahead between two fences.

Continue straight ahead on path 1 2 to Duchess Gate into Knole park.

Go through gate, take the immediate path on the L along the fence line, continue ahead through woods 3 4 until you reach a Knole Park entrance gate on the L.

At this point, turn R uphill 5 and continue ahead to 6.

At path junction just before 6 take track to the north and continue straight. Join main path and continue ahead as it bears left 7.

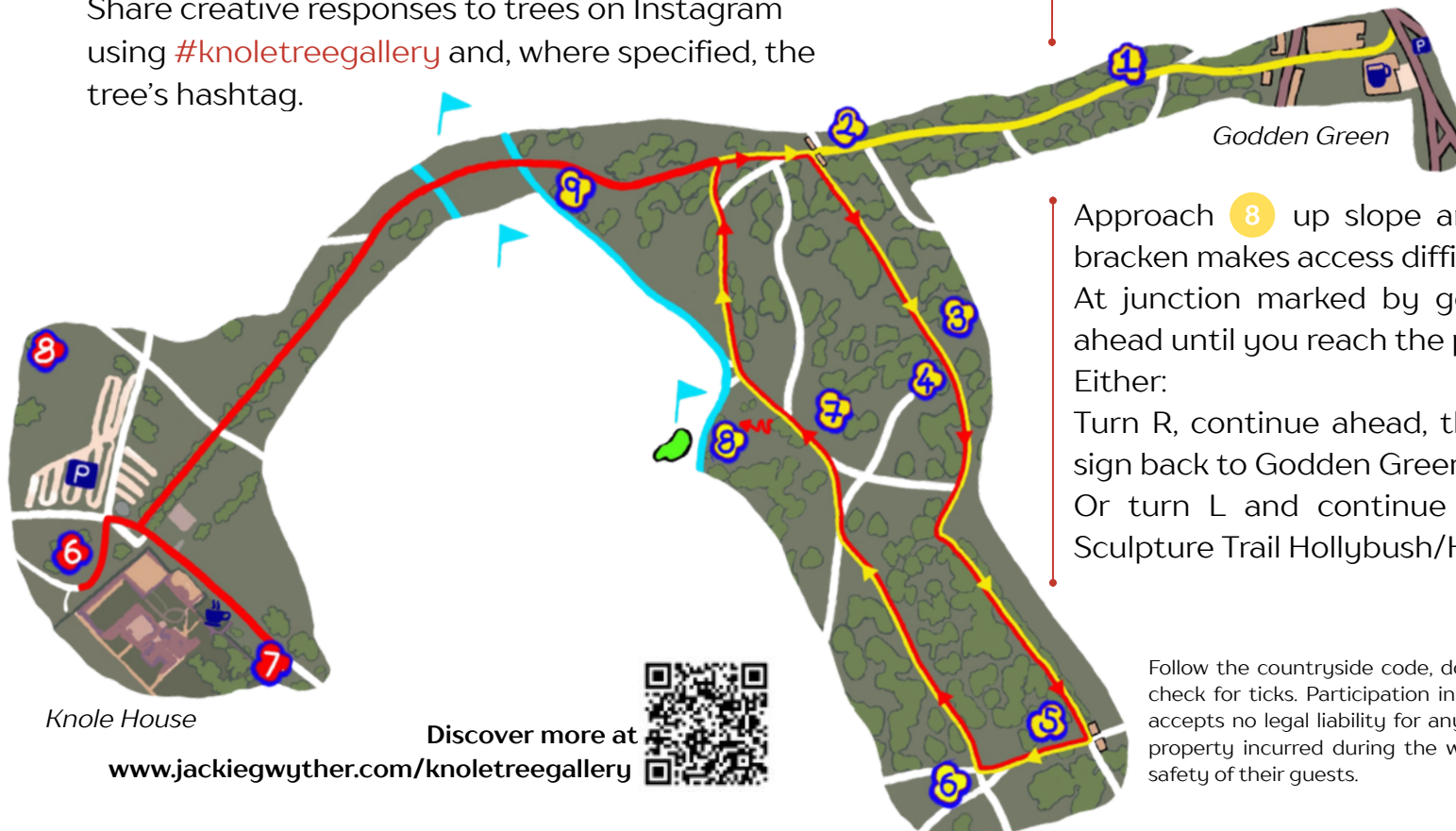
Approach 8 up slope and avoid the adjacent golf course. (High bracken makes access difficult in high summer).

At junction marked by golf club sign, turn R uphill and continue ahead until you reach the paved path.

Either:

Turn R, continue ahead, through gate, straight ahead, follow green sign back to Godden Green;

Or turn L and continue ahead to Knole House and back using Sculpture Trail Hollybush/Knole for red trees 6 7 & 8.
