scuba.enjoyable.woes

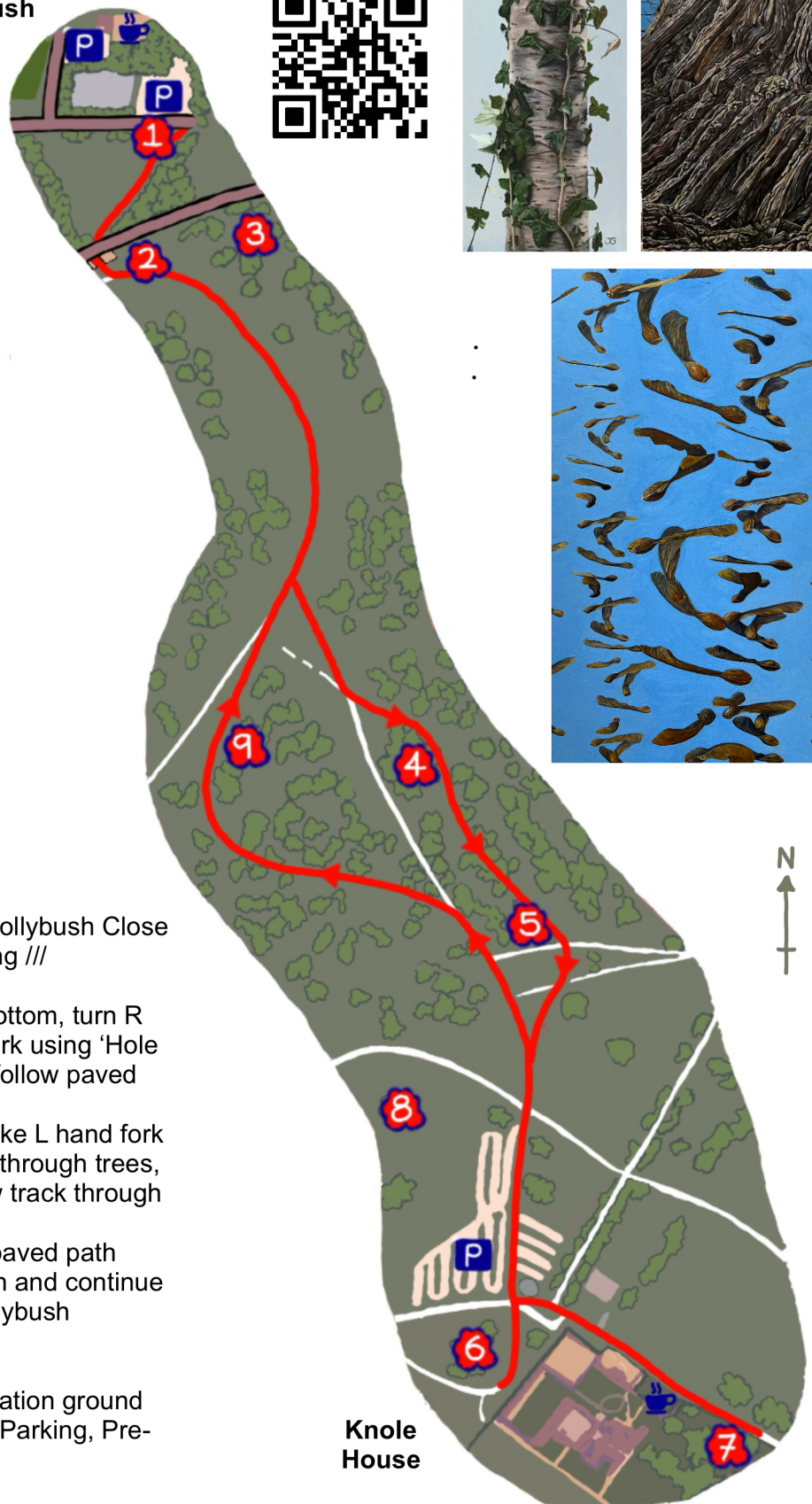
Enter field by 1, continue downhill to bottom, turn R
along Seal Hollow Road, enter Knole park using 'Hole
in the Wall' gate ///talked.herb.drill, 2, follow paved
path ahead, 3.

Where paved path begins to go uphill, take L hand fork
on faint track, then turn L on track uphill through trees,
4, continue, take left fork on path, Follow track through
woods to 5

continue ahead to Knole House on paved path
6, 7, return to the paved path, head north and continue
straight ahead, 8, 9, back to Hollybush
